

## Sessions

At Keep Guard Day Nursery we are able to provide childcare for 48 weeks of the year (all year) or offer spaces on a term time only basis at 38 weeks of the year, working to Bedford Borough's Academic Calendar. For families where children attend all year round, we do offer the option to reduce childcare in the school holidays to help with costs further if required.

The sessions start at either 8am or 9am and finish at 4pm or 5pm each day, Monday to Friday. You are able to opt for a mix of start and finish times, if required for your working or family commitments, however funding is only applied to these sessions from 9am till 12pm and again from 1pm till 4pm, term time. To ensure we provide a familiar environment and routine for your child, a minimum of two sessions per week will need to be booked. We no longer offer half-day sessions.

The only exception to this is if children are only entitled to 2 Year Old Disadvantaged Funding or Universal Funding for 3 and 4 Year Olds, where children will join us for either a morning session 9am-12pm, term time or afternoon session 1pm-4pm, term time, for their 15 hour entitlement. To ensure we provide a familiar environment and routine for your child, a minimum of three sessions per week (9 hours funding) will need to be booked.

If we are unable to provide you with a space, we may offer you an alternative session or day short term, until the space you require becomes available, or I am afraid add you to our ever-growing waiting list and let you know as soon as a space becomes available.
